Synopsis of Jesus Teaching - The Sermon on the Mount

- Beatitudes - Mt. 5:1-11 - Promises from God you can count on! (These help us to live for Christ. It's good to know that it's not in vain, it's not without reward!)
 - Those who know they need him will find him
 - He will comfort those who hurt
 - He will honor those who are humble
 - He will reward those who seek justice and righteousness
 - He will give mercy to those who show mercy
 - He will reveal himself to those who are pure at heart
 - He is proud of those who work for peace
 - Great reward awaits those who do right and stand up for the Kingdom.
- Mt. 5:13-16 - You are salt and light - preservative and goodness. We keep the world from chaos. We hold the world accountable for their actions. We stand for what's right, good and true. Stay salty, shine brightly!
- Mt. 5:17-20 - God's Word is the final authority. Obey it! Live it! (I have not come to destroy the commandments but to fulfill them.)
- Mt. 5:21-26 - Be considerate of everyone - be in control of your emotions and actions, reconcile with those you hurt, come to terms with those who seek compensation for a wrong suffered.
- Mt. 5:27-30 - Avoid people and situations that cause you to sin.
- Mt. 5:31-32 - Marriage is sacred. Honor it!
- Mt. 5:33-37 - Keep your Word
- Mt. 5:38-42 - Don't get even
- Mt. 5:43-48 - Love your enemies
- Mt. 6:1-4 - Give discreetly
- Mt. 6:5-15 - Prayer is between You and God alone
 - Pray to God
 - Pray for His Will to be done
 - Pray for his provision
 - Pray for his forgiveness
 - Pray for his protection
- Mt. 6:16-18 - Don't make a spectacle of your faith. Let your life be your witness.
- Mt. 6:19-21 - Make sure your hearts desire is for heavenly things instead of earthly things.
- Mt. 6:25-34 - Don't worry. God is able. God is in control.
- Mt. 6:33 - Seek His Kingdom first and foremost
- Mt. 7:1-2 - Don't condemn Others
- Mt. 7:3-6 - Make sure your life is in order before trying to offer advice to others
- Mt. 7:7-11 - Never Give Up! Keep trying! God will give you good things at the right time
- Mt. 7:12 - Do unto others as you would like them to do to you!
- Mt. 7:13 - Take the road less traveled
- Mt. 7:15-20 - Be discerning: not everyone is good, not everyone is honest, not everyone is wise
- Mt. 7:21-23 - Stay close to your God!
- Mt. 7:24-27 - Be wise - hear his words and do them so your life will be built on a solid foundation and you can have a great life!
